

Key Instant Recall Facts Year 1 and 2 - Summer 1 KIRFS- In KS1 we call them Key facts and show the children a key as a reminder we must lock them into our brain. By the end of this half term children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.	
Year 1	Year 2
I can count in 5s starting from 0 all the way to 50. 0, 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50.	I can count in 5s and recall multiplication facts e.g. $3 \times 5 = 15$ $5 \times 5 = 25$
