Latimer Close - Safety

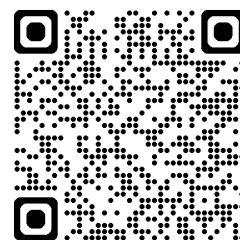
Please ensure our children have safe access into school by limiting cars into Latimer Close. Only people with disabled badges can park on the double yellow lined areas.
