Walkie Wheelie Wednesday every Wednesday. Walk or wheel to school!

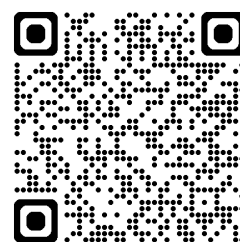
Latimer Close - Safety
